Mahan Gallery Opens New Exhibition, Greg Davis, Brian Campbell and Brett Carron: New Work, on Saturday, August 7, 2004.

Davis, Campbell, and Carron, CCAD students and residents of Columbus will be exhibiting work in August at the Mahan Gallery, 1042 North High Street, Columbus, Ohio 43201.

Greg's works depict imagined spaces built from the language of landscape painting and architecture expressed through large scale paintings on paper and panel. The spaces that are carefully constructed out of acrylic, watercolor, graphite and ink range from the completely abstract to familiar representations of suburban fragments and fashioned landscapes.

Brian's work explores the idea of transformations and symbolic juxtaposition of representational objects that serve as vessels for activity. These objects are pipes, highways, machinery, bulldozers, ribbons, and line drawings. Brian uses a wide range of paintings and drawing materials, as well as appliqué vinyl, screen-printing and gunpowder.

Brett's work is informed by an expanding field of devices ranging from the literary to the historical. He employs various techniques to interpret these modes of information including model making, found objects, woodworking, digital imaging, video, and furniture making.

Brett graduated from CCAD in 2002 earning a BFA in fine arts. Greg and Brian will be graduating in the spring of 2005. All three have been recipients of scholarships from CCAD.

The opening reception will take place Saturday, August 7, 6-10pm. The show will be on display from August 7 through August 28.

The Mahan Gallery focuses on emerging and mid-career artists working in a variety of media, including painting, photography, and sculpture. Gallery hours are Monday-Friday from 11 am-7 pm; Saturday-Sunday 12 pm- 6 pm.
